BALDOCK PARKING MANAGEMENT

2010 Consultation Options

Zone 1a - Parking Management Options

Option B – No Waiting at Any Time (double yellow lines) at junctions and very narrow sections of road.

This will protect visibility and turning movements at junctions and help prevent parking on very narrow sections of road.

Option C – Permit Parking Only (Monday to Friday 8am to 6pm)

Anyone wishing to park on street during the above days/hours will need to purchase and display a valid permit. Permits can be purchased for residents, visitors and businesses' operational vehicles. Priority will be given to residents but consideration may be given to staff parking for businesses' located in the zone. Yellow line restrictions may also be needed as per Option B.

Option D - Permit Parking Only (Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm)

As Option C except the permit parking scheme will run Monday to Saturday.

Option E – Permit Parking and limited waiting in Church Street

As Options C or D except that short stay parking for up to 2 hours will be available in Church Street without the need to display a permit.

Option F – Permit Parking and limited waiting in whole of Zone 1

As Options C or D except that short stay parking for up to 2 hours will be available in the whole zone without the need to display a permit.

ZONE 1b - Parking Management Options

Option B – No Waiting at Any Time (double yellow lines) at junctions and very narrow sections of road.

This will protect visibility and turning movements at junctions and help prevent parking on very narrow sections of road.

Option C – No Waiting Monday to Friday 10am to 11am and 4pm to 5pm (single yellow line)

This will prevent all day parking. Residents and visitors will <u>not</u> be permitted to park on street on the above days/times.

Option D – Permit Parking Only (Monday to Friday 10am to 11am and 4pm to 5pm)

The same restrictions as Option C except anyone displaying a permit will be exempt from the restriction. Priority will be given to residents and their visitors for purchasing permits. Yellow line restrictions may also be needed as per Option B.

Option E – Permit Parking Only (Monday to Friday 8am to 6pm)

The same as Option D except that the permit hours are all day. Priority will be given to residents and their visitors for purchasing permits.

ZONE 2 - Parking Management Options

Option B – No Waiting at Any Time (double yellow lines) at junctions and very narrow sections of road.

This will protect visibility and turning movements at junctions and help prevent parking on very narrow sections of road.

Option C – <u>In Simpsons Drive only</u> Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm

On the <u>southside</u> unrestricted kerbspace in front of Simpson Court, provide parking for Disabled Badge Holders and some limited waiting for up to 2 hours. This will assist visitors to Simpsons Court – up to 7 spaces.

On the <u>northside</u> the unrestricted kerbspace adjacent to the Community Centre be reserved for Business Permit Holders (permits will be sold to Baldock businesses) – up to 8 spaces.

No change to existing parking restrictions in Simpsons Drive. Yellow line restrictions may also be needed as per Option B.

Option D – <u>In the Twitchell and Thurnall Close only</u> Permit Parking Only - Monday to Friday 8am to 6pm

Anyone wishing to park on street during the above days/hours will need to purchase and display a valid permit. Priority will be given to residents and visitors. Yellow line restrictions may also be needed as per Option B.

Option E – In the Twitchell and Thurnall Close only Permit Parking Only - Monday to Friday 10am to 11am + 4pm to 5pm As a variation on Option D the permit controlled hours are reduced. Outside these hours anyone can park on these two streets.

ZONE 3 - Parking Management Options

Option B – No Waiting at Any Time (double yellow lines) at junctions and very narrow sections of road.

This will protect visibility and turning movements at junctions and help prevent parking on very narrow sections of road.

Option C – Permit Parking Only (Monday to Friday 10am to 11am + 4pm to 5pm)

Anyone wishing to park on street during the above days/hours will need to purchase and display a valid permit. Permits can be purchased for residents and visitors. Yellow line restrictions may also be needed as per Option B.

Option D – Permit Parking Only (Monday to Friday 8am to 6pm)

The same as Option C except that the permit hours are all day.

ZONE 4 - Parking Management Options

Option B – No Waiting at Any Time (double yellow lines) at junctions and very narrow sections of road.

This will protect visibility and turning movements at junctions and help prevent parking on very narrow sections of road.

Option C – No Waiting Monday to Friday 10am to 11am and 4pm to 5pm (single yellow line)

This will prevent all day parking but residents/visitors will <u>not</u> be permitted to park on the above days/times.

Option D – Permit Parking Only (Monday to Friday 10am to 11am and 4pm to 5pm)

The same restrictions as Option C except anyone displaying a permit will be exempt from the restriction. Priority will be given to residents and their visitors for permits. Yellow line restrictions may also be needed as per Option B.

Option E – Permit Parking Only (Monday to Friday 8am to 6pm)

The same as Options D except that the permit hours are all day. Priority will be given to residents and their visitors for permits.

ZONE 5 - Parking Management Options

Option B – No Waiting at Any Time (double yellow lines) at junctions and very narrow sections of road.

This will protect visibility and turning movements at junctions and help prevent parking on very narrow sections of road.

Option C – No Waiting Monday to Friday 10am to 11am and 4pm to 5pm (single yellow line)

This will prevent all day parking but residents/visitors will <u>not</u> be permitted to park on street on the above days/times.

Option D – Permit Parking Only (Monday to Friday 10am to 11am and 4pm to 5pm)

The same restrictions as Option C except anyone displaying a permit will be exempt from the restriction. Priority will be given to residents and their visitors for permits. Yellow line restrictions may also be needed as per Option B.
