Baldock CDO has also written to the Abbot Brothers on 16 <sup>th</sup> May for clarification on the exact timings of the Baldock Fair so that Highways can commence with the planning for the road closures etc The Abbot Brothers have also been contacted with regards to the Waste Management plans for this years event.
