Brief details:

Small Acts of Kindness CIC is seeking £2,100 funding support from across the 5 Area Committees to assist with the purchase and distribution of 150 Warm In Winter Gift Bags to older people living in North Herts.

Elderly residents in Royston, Hitchin, Baldock, Letchworth, Whitwell, Ashwell, Knebworth have been identified as needing support.

Requests for the bags have come from North Herts CVS, North Herts Community Transport and Hertfordshire Independent Living Services.

In terms of funding £300 is being requested from Baldock, Royston and Southern Rural Committees, whilst the group is seeking £600 from the Hitchin & Letchworth Area Committees.

Comments from Development Officer:

Small Acts of Kindness was set up in 2014.

It is a Community Interest Company and is made up of 5 Committee Members and 50 Volunteers. Since 2014, the group have been sourcing and distributing Warm in Winter Gift Bags to elderly people.

The bags contain a large fleecy blanket, thermal socks, hat and gloves and a mug together with a selection of hot drinks and soup. Demand for this service has increased annually from 60 in 2014 to 800 in 2015. So far this winter (2016/17) the group has had requests for over 1,400 bags and this figure is likely to rise to 2,000 by Spring 2017.

The application is criteria compliant and the officer recommendation is for the award of £300.

This organisation receives no Rate Support or other formal benefits from NHDC.

This organisation has not received an NHDC grant in the last five years.
