Extract from Hitchin Initiative Response to NHDC Car Parking Charge Proposals October 2014 and the Hitchin Initiative Alternative Proposals.

Summary

- 1. It is not necessary to bring in charges that could cause the 'tipping point' with the consequential, irreversible damage to our Town Centre vibrancy.
- 2. Ideally there would be no car parking charge increases in North Herts until after the 2015 Car Parking Review. We would welcome the time to carry out further work with NHDC to ensure a more complete, forward thinking holistic solution that takes full account of the recent Government reviews relating to car parking charge transparency.
- 3. In the absence of the above not being a viable solution Hitchin Initiative, on behalf of thousands of others commend the Hitchin Initiative alternative plan, a constructive alternative which will have popular support.
- 4. Hitchin Initiative urge you not to ignore the overwhelming voice of public and business opinion that says 'NO' to Evening and Sunday charging.

Hitchin Initiative are grateful to the Portfolio Holder, Hitchin Ward Councillors, officers of the Council, the civic groups and societies, representatives from the Hitchin business community and the public for their engagement in this consultation.



Q1 North Hertfordshire District Council is committed to raising car parking charges by 16.6% overall to make up for inflation since the last increases in 2010. This decision has already been made and we now look for the most sensible way to implement this for all sections of the Hitchin community. Hitchin Initiative proposes a re-alignment of current car parking charges to satisfy NHDC's requirement to raise car parking revenue by £150,000 per annum from Hitchin. Our plan negates the need to introduce Sunday and evening charges and promotes the use of The Lairage multi storey car park without raising the current 1 hour charge in all other car parks. The Hitchin Initiative plan would simplify the charging regime in short-term car parks to £1 for 1 hour, £2 for 2 hours, £3 for 3 hours and £4 for 4 hours thus relieving the frustration of scrabbling for mixed coinage or the irritation that payment machines do not give change.
