

Developing community capacity /consult with users:			
Organising Information Event, Talk and Open Day	√		During the past 6 month period of April – September 2016, we had three Open Days to identify the learning needs of local BME communities and also consult with them about our future operations.
			In addition to this we have organised a special Open Day on the 4 th August to discuss how to support the Syrian refugee families to be settled in North Hertfordshire. Over 72 people attended this event and came out with enormous amount of support to these families.
Bi-Monthly Public Meeting	√		During April — Sept. 2016 we had 3 consultations with local communities to receive feedback on our ongoing activities and also planning for future activities. As a result and in line with the demand from the communities, we have arranged new project and activities to be launched from October 2016. They are a Job course to help unemployed people in the district to return to work, a regular Maths & English tuition course for the GCSE pupils, a new basic IT, an advanced IT, Microsoft Word & EXCEL courses to name a few.
			People also requested for a Social Media course for the retired people and a digital photography course which will be arranged subject to securing funding.
Promoting services to the local communities	V		We have been producing leaflets, posting our new events and activities on Facebook, What-Apps and on our websites.

Develop community consultation group	√	We in partnership with various agencies have carried out various consultation events in the last six months e.g. North Hertfordshire Homes, VIEWPOINT Mental Health Services, Hertfordshire Constabulary, Hertfordshire Fire & rescue Services, NHS Ambulance Services and QUANTUM Care.

Set up Women's Group	√	We had 5 user led women's group. They are: Mothers & Toddlers Learning Support Group, Punjabi Older women's Group, North Herts Italian Women's Group, Middle-Eastern Women Group and Mama Sugar Baby's group.
Set up Older People's Group	√	We have set up 8 Older people's Groups; Afro-Caribbean Senior Luncheon Club, Italian Pension Club, Senior Asians Luncheon Club, Italian Older people's group, Punjabi Older Men's Group, Punjabi Older women's Group, a Fitness Group for Elders and Polish Elders Club.
Services for the children and young people	√	During the past six months we were running a Polish language school to support children from the Reception class to A-Level, An Italian language school to support age 5-11 children, a French language school to support children age 5-8. We also had Math & English support homework club for key stage 2 & 3 pupils.
