





The Urban Transport Plan

The UTP sets out the proposed transport improvements for the next 5 years. The plan is designed to meet local needs. Following consultation, the UTP will be adopted by Hertfordshire County Council in its role as Transport Authority.



The map overleaf displays the improvements we propose to make to the roads and transport infratructure across Hitchin over the next 5 years. In addition to these, the UTP also proposes a number of other schemes which are designed to complement the physical improvements. See the green box on the opposite page for a list of these.

Walking Schemes
