NOTICE OF A RESOLUTION MADE PURSUANT TO SCHEDULE 4 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) ACT 1982

At a meeting of Council on 9th February 2012, the Council resolved to designate streets within North Hertfordshire for the purposes of Street Trading, pursuant to Schedule 4, Paragraph 2 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982.

The Council resolved:

That all streets within the town centres of Baldock, Hitchin, Letchworth Garden City and Royston, as annotated within Appendices A to D of the Street Trading Policy, and all arterial roads within North Hertfordshire, as listed in Paragraph 2.2.3 of the Street Trading Policy attached as Appendix C to the report, be designated as consent streets for the purpose of Schedule 4 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982.

The effect of this resolution is to require any person wishing to trade on or from a consent street to first obtain a consent from North Hertfordshire District Council. All other streets within North Hertfordshire not listed in the resolution above, for example the rural villages, are not affected by this resolution and remain undesignated streets not requiring consents to trade.

The designation of streets and the introduction of the street trading requirements takes effect from 2nd April 2012.
