Aims and Objectives of the R.I.S.E. Project

- Identity
- Self esteem
- Relationship Awareness
- Being Safe
- Promoting positive actions of young people in the community
- Role models

The first year of the R.I.S.E. Project starts in October 2012 in The Priory School with Year 9s.

The Community work will start in the Summer term 2013 in the three areas identified.

The project will culminate in a Showcase Event in Hitchin Market Place on Saturday 20th July 2013 where the young people's achievements will be celebrated.

On the evening of Saturday 20th July 2013 a 'prom' style celebration will be held for the young people in Bancroft Youth Centre.

The School programme will be run by Groundwork and Phase and the Community Programme by Child UK and Hitchin Christian Centre.

It is hoped that the project will be rolled out over all three senior schools in the following years.

Funding

The project has been initiated because of £5,000 from Groundwork for a youth project in Hitchin

A budget for the project has been estimated at £17,000, in the first year which includes the showcase event
