Background

On the 28th January 2014 Cabinet approved delegated authority to the Strategic Director of Customer Services, in consultation with the Portfolio Holder for Leisure, for the final submission of the Stage 1 Heritage Lottery Fund (HLF) bid for the refurbishments of Bancroft Recreation Ground. The bid was submitted in February 2014.
