

JSCC - Local Government Annual Pay Negotiations 2011/12

The main unions submitted a claim for:-

A £250 flat rate increase for all staff.

The employers held a series of consultation briefings in December on the following options:

Option 1 - Not to make an offer.

Option 2 - To make an offer in line with Government pay policy.

Option 3 - To propose a pay cut.

Option 4 - To propose a package covering pay and conditions.

The Employers informed the local government trade unions on 17th February that they are unable to offer any increase in pay for 2011/12.

The trade unions have not made a formal response but do have updates on their websites.

It has also been confirmed by the Employers that there will be no pay offer for Chief Executives or Chief Officers.
