The supply of alcohol is for consumption on and off the premises. The regulated entertainment is for indoors only.

The Sub-Committee have read the material presented to us and have listened to all the evidence and submissions.

The Sub-Committee has also heard the oral evidence from the Environmental Health Department on the grounds of public nuisance relating to noise emanating from the premises and the representations from the residents in relation to crime and disorder caused by patrons leaving the premises and public nuisance, including noise, in the vicinity.

The Sub-Committee has considered the National Guidance and the Statement of Licensing Policy and has come to the following decision:

The application is approved subject to conditions and restrictions, including the conditions proposed by the applicant in their operating schedule as amended by the conditions offered by the applicant at 6.2 of the licensing officers report and the embedded conditions which are not inconsistent with the application and the Licensing Act 2003.

The licensable hours for the sale of alcohol are granted.

The hours for all regulated entertainment will be restricted to 2300hrs 7 days a week, with the exception of the hours on Christmas Eve and New Years Eve which are granted.

The hours for late night refreshment are restricted to the terminal hour for the sale of alcohol.

A condition on the licence is to be imposed as follows:

"Measures will be taken to ensure that music/noise cannot be heard beyond the immediate vicinity of the premises."

In addition the Sub-Committee wish to remove the statement at 4.6.2 that "any live music will end at one hour before the terminal hour" as this is no longer relevant.

The Sub-Committee would also like to amend the condition at 6.2 of the licensing officer's report to read:

"The occasions that performances, including live music, karaoke and DJ music, will be limited to a maximum of 12 times in any one 12 month period and will cease at 2300hrs, with the exception of Christmas Eve and New Years Eve which are granted".

The restrictions and limitations have been deemed necessary to prevent public nuisance in the vicinity of the premises.
