The Sub-Committee has considered the National Guidance and the Statement of Licensing Policy and has come to the following decision:</p> <p>The application is <b>approved</b> subject to the conditions and hours as are set out below.</p> <p><b>1. <u>OPENING HOURS</u></b></p> <p>The permitted opening hours are:</p> <p>Monday to Thursday 1200hrs to 2400hrs  Friday &amp; Saturday 1200hrs to 0030hrs the following morning  Sunday 1200hrs to 2330hrs</p> <p>These hours are to apply each day of the year with the exception of New Year's Eve. 	<p><b>PART M – Supply of alcohol</b></p> <p>Monday to Thursday 1200hrs to 2300hrs  Friday &amp; Saturday 1200hrs to 2330hrs  Sunday 1200hrs to 2200hrs</p> <p>These hours are to apply each day of the year with the exception of the following days, when the permitted hours for the supply of alcohol are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bank Holiday Mondays 1200hrs to 2300hrs</li> <li>• Christmas Eve 1200hrs to 2330hrs</li> <li>• New Years Eve 1200hrs to 0200hrs the following morning</li> </ul>
<p><b>CONDITIONS PROPOSED BY APPLICANT</b></p>	<p>This licence will be subject to the conditions offered by the applicant in part Q in order to promote the four licensing objectives set out in of their application.</p>
<p><b>EFFECT OF FAILING TO COMPLY WITH CONDITIONS EXPLAINED TO APPLICANT</b></p>	<p>The Sub-Committee has explained to the applicant the effect of failure to comply with any of the conditions attached to the licence or certificate is a criminal offence, which upon conviction, would result in a fine of up to £20,000 or up to six months imprisonment or both.</p>
<p><b>COMMENCEMENT DATE</b></p>	<p>This licence will come into effect from the second appointed day, namely the 24<sup>th</sup> of November 2005.</p>
<p><b>RIGHTS OF REVIEW</b></p>	<p>At any stage, following the grant of a premises licence, a responsible authority, such as the Police or an interested party, such as a resident living in the vicinity of the premises may ask the licensing authority to review the licence because of a matter arising at the premises in connection with any of the four licensing objectives. The review is a request for the Council to look at the existing licence and decide whether its conditions are adequate to meet the four licensing objectives defined under the Licensing Act 2003.</p>
