3. Response from Focus Groups

The majority of participants felt that, in an ideal world, all 47 equipped play areas across the district would be maintained, while also recognising that investment is in short supply and that change is thus inevitable.

Alternative suggestions made by focus groups as to how the 47 equipped play areas could be retained related to seeking sponsorship, investment and assistance from local businesses, housing developers and community/volunteer groups. This alternative approach has been adopted and Cabinet have allowed until 1st March 2018 for interested parties to come forward with sustainable proposals for play areas and pavilions.
