							<p>There are two ways to proceed if the JMP give its support to further feasibility, design and consultation work. Option 1 would be to focus solely on developing a scheme which includes chicanes, although the costs to achieve this solution may ultimately require the purchasing/dedication of third party land.</p> <p>Option 2 would be a more holistic approach similar to the process operated in the Parish Plan where by a consultation process would be undertaken to establish all the traffic related concerns in the village and define the extent and scope of the project. Outline scheme(s) could then be developed for further consultation and costing. The necessary delivery costs including detailed design, formal consultation and construction would be subject of a separate and additional funding allocation.</p>

HOWEVER THESE WORKS ARE NOW BEING PROGRESSED BY THE SAFER ROUTES TO SCHOOL TEAM AND THERE IS NO LONGER ANY NEED TO FUND THESE WORKS
