Small Acts of Kindness was set up in 2014.

It is a Community Interest Company and is made up of 5 Committee Members and 50 Volunteers.

Since 2014, the group has been sourcing and distributing Warm in Winter Gift Bags to elderly people each year.

The bags contain a large fleecy blanket, thermal socks, hat and gloves and a mug together with a selection of hot drinks and soup.

Demand for this service has increased annually from 60 in 2014 to 800 in 2015. So far this winter (2016/17) the group has had requests for over 1,400 bags and this figure is likely to rise to 2,000 by Spring 2017.

The application is crtiteria compliant and the officer recommendation is for the award of £300.

This organisation receives no Rate Support or other formal benefits from NHDC.

This organisation has not received an NHDC grant in the last five years.
