Brief details:

Pirton Joycare provides services & activities to enhance the quality of life of elderly people, aged 65 and over living in and around the Pirton area. The Group operates a Lunch club, arranges shopping trips, runs a Good Neighbourhood Scheme, chiropody clinic, activity outings , a walking group, careline and wheelchair service. A letter accompanying the application from a resident states that without Pirton Joycare she would find it very difficult were it not for their Good Neighbour Scheme. The group is looking for a grant award from the Committee to help meet its yearly expenditure which equates to approx. £5,400 and includes Minibus costs, Insurance Premiums, CRB Checks and Hall Hire costs. The Group gets approx. £2,300 from it's members, £500 from the Parish Council, £260 in donations with the balance being sought from fundraising and grants.
