Comments from Development Officer:

The Ickleford Cricket Club is fully a constituted Club affiliated to the England & Wales Cricket Board through the Hertfordshire Cricket Board. Its aims & objectives are consistent with other well run and operated sporting club within the District. It has a progressive Colts section and is seeking to achieve Clubmark status.

The Club had a turnover of approximately £21k last year with a small operating balance of £2,800. The main sources of income being via fundraising and donations year on year and main outgoings relate to maintaining the ground and associated equipment.

The Club last received a grant award from the Area Committee back in March 2009 for £1,250 to assist with the refurbishment of the External Cricket Nets Facility at the ground.

The CDM has liaised with the Authority's Sports Development Officer re this matter and as a result both officers support this application for grant funding to the Area Committee, as it demonstrates the Authority's supporting approach to groups & clubs that work and deliver services within their local communities.

The Community Development Officer has examined this application against the Authority's Area Grants Policy, the organisation's accounts and grant history, and considers it an eligible application to put before the Committee.
