Once funding is secured, the defibrillator will be installed on one of the outside stores at the Red Lion pub.

Local residents will be informed and a training session will be organised, although the model planned is one which anyone can use very easily.

Such provision has the potential to be a life-saving initiative for local residents and also for the many visitors to the area for leisure purposes.

The Parish is seeking a grant in the region of £895 to assist with the total cost for provision of £1,395.

The Community Development Officer has examined this application against the Authority's Area Grants Policy, the organisation's accounts and grant history, and considers it an eligible application to put before the Committee.
