Since 2014, the group has been sourcing and distributing Warm in Winter Gift Bags to elderly people each year. The bags contain a large fleecy blanket, thermal socks, hat and gloves and a mug together with a selection of hot drinks and soup.			
	Demand for this service has increased annually from 60 in 2014 to 800 in 2015. So far this winter (2016/17) the group has had requests for over 1,400 bags and this figure is likely to rise to 2,000 by Spring 2017.
