The Templars, 20 High Street, Baldock Planning Application 22/00927/FP Crime Figures

For the purpose of commenting on planning applications Hertfordshire Constabulary's Crime Prevention Design Service use the data from <u>www.police.uk</u>. The reason for this is that it is in the public domain and has already been sanitized. In addition, if anyone wishes to check the figures quoted they can do so easily.

To get the figures that are quoted in this report I just looked at the High Street in Baldock between October 2019 and September 2022. I chose to ignore the Tesco site at the top of the High Street as this was not relevant to this application. The time frame was chosen so that it covered pre and post Covid. The table below shows the number of crimes reported over this period and the number of cases that were recoded as antisocial behaviour (ASB)

When I check on our system and looked at the address, I could only find one incident listed – this was not related to ASB or crime, so it was ignored. Yes, the reports for ASB and assaults have gone up but so have the total crimes, not all these can be directly laid as due to the provision of a temporary housing shelter. For example the Haven in Stevenage is run by the same company, there is ASB nearby but that is due to groups of youths who congregate in the local park, rather than the service users.

Additional clarification:

1. Where the new facility is?

Protea Way, LGC (agreed @ Feb 2021 PCC)

2. When it will be open?

No confirmation as yet (the applicant Haven First are being absorbed in to OneYMCA, and although positive indications on delivery, no firm dates as yet.

3. How many rooms / occupiers it will have?

40 rooms, mainly single occupancy

4. That all of those living at Templars will be moved to the new facility and that there will not be a situation where both the new facility will be in use and Templar will still be needed?

Correct, all residents will be moved to the new facility. Templars would not be used for homeless accommodation at that point.

5. Please can you find out how Haven manage / view anti-social behaviour from residents in the immediate vicinity of the site.

Anti- social behaviour is not tolerated. As mentioned in the planning notes in the link above, residents are aware of being good neighbours and know that they put their licence at risk and may be evicted if they are in breach of the terms of their licence. The service is staffed 24/7, providing full support to residents.
