Councillor Chris Lucas to Councillor Tamsin Thomas, Executive Member for Enterprise:

'In the Members Information Service (MIS) bulletin released on 3rd July, I read with interest that BTG Eddison's have been appointed to undertake a new campaign marketing for Charnwood House, Hitchin this summer.

Can the Portfolio Holder for Enterprise explain how long the property has been vacant?'

(B) Thomas Belamy House, Hitchin Vacancy Period

Councillor Chris Lucas to Councillor Tamsin Thomas, Executive Member for Enterprise:

'Can the Portfolio Holder for Enterprise explain how long Thomas Bellamy House in Hitchin has been vacant?'

(C) Charnwood House and Thomas Bellamy House, Hitchin Maintenance and Security Costs
