Royston.

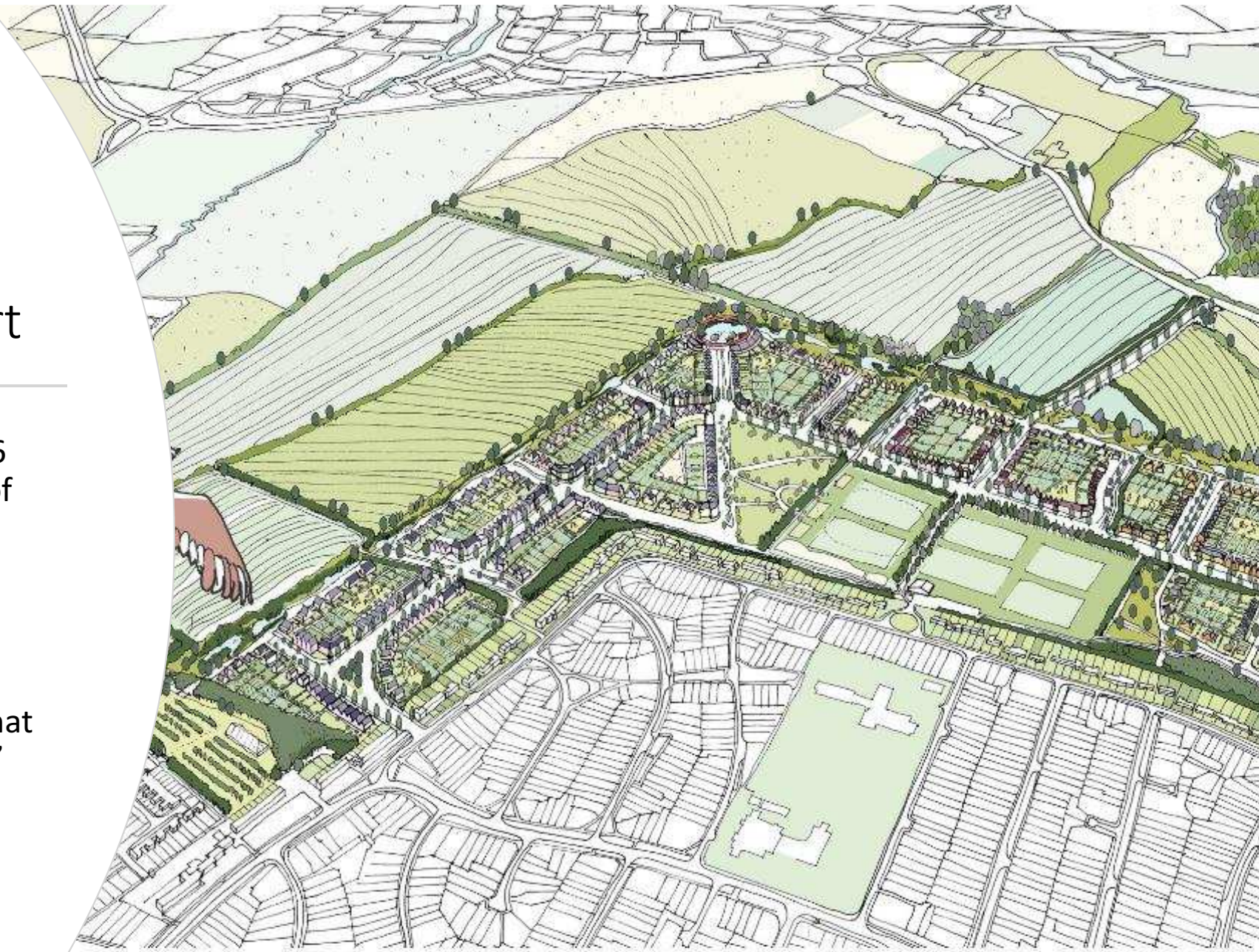




## S106 funding for sustainable transport
