The development would therefore be contrary to Policies 6 (Rural area beyond the green belt), 29 (Rural housing needs) and 57 (Residential Guidelines and standards) of the local plan which seek, amongst other things, to protect the countryside from development that would harm its character and appearance.  The Inspector also concluded that the proposed development would harm the setting of the listed building. The development is therefore in conflict with paragraphs 126 – 141 of the Framework and section 66 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990 which requires, amongst other things, that great weight and special attention is paid to the desirability of preserving the listed building or its setting.
