Officer Summary

Reed Cricket Club is a vibrant and active community cricket club, serving the local community. The club offers a range of opportunities for people of all ages and abilities.

The club would like funding towards refurbishing their kitchen, to bring it up to date, ideally in time for the new season (April 2024). The current kitchen is not functional and does not meet the needs of the club. It is unsightly and does not reflect well on the club. The kitchen has outdated fixtures and appliances. It is also poorly lit, and it lacks any sense of style.

The kitchen is too small to accommodate the number of people who use it and requires basic equipment to be updated. The kitchen is also difficult to clean, which makes it a burden for club members to maintain.

A refurbished kitchen would allow the club to:

- Host more events and functions, which would generate more revenue for the club.
- Attract more members, which would strengthen the club and increase its visibility in the community.
- Provide a safe and hygienic environment for club members and guests.
- Increase the functionality of the kitchen, which would make it easier for club members to prepare food and clean up.
- Improve the appearance of the club, making it more inviting for members and guests.

Overall, refurbishing the kitchen would be a significant investment in the future of Reed Cricket Club. It would enable them to run more events to support the club and increase external hires of the club house. This in turn will increase income generation for the club and make it more financially sustainable going forward.
