Districtwide Community Updates

- The Community Partnerships team worked with the Royal British Legion and Letchworth BID to deliver the Letchworth Remembrance Day parade on 10 November 2024.
- Grants of between £5,000 and £20,000 have been approved for a range of community groups across the district using money from North Herts Prosperity Fund, a pot of £210,000 funded by the UK Government. The press release is available <u>here</u>.
- The Community Partnerships Team have launched the North Herts Heroes Awards in which we aim to celebrate people in the local community.
