Thank you for your time this morning to discuss the Conservative Group proposal to freeze parking charges.

Following discussion with my group, we wish to call in the decision made by Cabinet on Tuesday 11 February relating to the Proposed Parking Tariffs for 2025/26, because we believe it would be in the public interest for this matter to be subject to additional scrutiny and debate by colleagues at Council.

We are pursuing this course of action because of the adverse impact this decision will have on the economy of North Hertfordshire, particularly its impact on local independent businesses situated in our town centres who are already under additional pressures as a result of the policy decisions of the Government.

Both the Conservatives and Liberal Democrats have raised concerns surrounding the implementation of this policy, and due to the political makeup of the Council, it is only right opposition colleagues have an opportunity to further scrutinise and potentially amend the proposals of the administration.
