<p>Bubble Works Run Community is a running club founded on being a social, inclusive and fun group that brings people of all capabilities together around sport and specifically running. The membership is completely free and includes over 500 members, with at least 90% based in Hitchin.</p> <p>They are applying for funding to go towards:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The cost of hiring Ridlins Athletics Track in Stevenage for two separate sessions, each lasting two hours - £86 an hour</li> <li>• Coach travel to attend a half marathon race in Cambridge – for runners and supporters - £650</li> <li>• Safeguarding and Welfare Officer Course - £35</li> <li>• DBS check for Welfare Officer - £21.50</li> </ul> <p>The club have received enquiries from members for track running days. Track running provides a safe, structured and high-quality surface for runners of all abilities. This is especially needed in darker months, when running on streets can be daunting, particularly for lesser experienced runners.</p> <p>Providing coach travel for members and supporters promotes accessibility to take part in the half marathon.</p> <p>The club are contributing £400 towards costs through fundraising.</p>
