This is a formal objection to the granting of a Alcohol license to the above premises. We object on the grounds of public nuisance.

Living in the town centre we do not expect peace and quiet, however the granting of a license to the above will cause us significant distress as the premises is directly attached to the bedroom in the flat.

This is not the case with The Kite at the Red Hart on the other wall. The downstairs is a restaurant which is relatively quiet. The noisy part (the bar) is separated from us by staff accommodation and located at the rear, so the noise is at an acceptable level.

The other premises that affects us is a Chinese takeaway which does not serve alcohol and does not have customers standing around so the level of noise is again within acceptable levels.

This will not be the case if a license is granted to 26 Bucklersbury. If a license is granted we will suffer unacceptable levels of noise until midnight and after (clearing up, locking up etc.) therefore we object.
