<p>6<sup>th</sup> Hitchin Scout group is a thriving community youth organisation, based at The Priory School in Hitchin with 69 young members in the Beavers, Cubs and Scouts. They are looking for funding towards a one-night residential camp at Boyd Camp, Henlow.</p> <p>The funding would go towards:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Campsite fees for 75 people (54 young people, 6 young leaders and 15 adults) (£412.50)</li> <li>• Accommodation in the on-site bus for their younger Beavers (£100)</li> <li>• Adventure activities including air rifle shooting and rafting for Cubs and Scouts, plus garden games and mini crossbows for Beavers (£455)</li> <li>• Hall hire and board games for evening activities (£40)</li> <li>• Food costs at approximately £8 per person (£600)</li> <li>• Commemorative camp badges (£120)</li> </ul> <p>This will be the first residential camp experience for many of their younger members, particularly their Beavers. The camp will provide essential outdoor learning opportunities, help develop independence and resilience, and allow young people to experience activities not available in their regular weekly meetings.</p> <p>By subsidising the costs, they can ensure that all young people in their group can participate regardless of their family's financial circumstances, removing barriers to accessing Scouting's developmental opportunities.</p> <p>Summary of contributions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• £810 from 54 family contributions</li> <li>• £17.50 from 6th Hitchin group reserves</li> </ul>
