Thank you for providing Wymondley Parish Council with an opportunity to comment on this matter.

I have consulted the Parish Council, and am able to advise you on members' behalf that they are supportive of the funding application proposed by Bim Afolami MP being pursued.

They are also generally supportive of regeneration and redevelopment of Churchgate, preferably with mixed use buildings, i.e. retail, offices/commercial and residential. Members also believe it is important that any such redevelopment should include satisfactory provision for parking, (which might encourage visitors from surrounding villages and elsewhere); and that development should not be at the expense of existing parking facilities.

Additionally, in the light of previous redevelopment proposals for Churchgate, it is important that any future proposals are taken forward in partnership with competent professionals; and that there is comprehensive public consultation.
