

#### Indices of Multiple Deprivation (2015) - Overview

- There is one LSOA in Letchworth, on the Jackmans estate, which ranks in the top 20% most deprived neighbourhoods in England. This area is also the seventh most deprived in Hertfordshire.
- There are three areas, on the Jackmans, Wilbury and Grange, which are in the top 30% most deprived in England.
- In contrast, there are three areas in the south of the town which are in the top 10% least deprived in England.




#### Indices of Multiple Deprivation (2015)

This map shows Letchworth's LSOAs on the index of multiple deprivation. This measure accounts for all 7 areas of deprivation. The darker shaded areas represent the most deprived areas in Hertfordshire.

• 10 Letchworth LSOAs are in the top 20% most deprived in Hertfordshire.

A further 5 LSOAs are in the top 40% most deprived.


• This map shows the spread of deprivation within Letchworth, as opposed to as a part of the regional picture.



#### IMD: Housing and Services

This map shows barriers to housing and services on the index of multiple deprivation. The darker shading of an area represents a higher level of deprivation.

- 4 LSOAs are in the most deprived group for barriers to housing and services.
- A further 4 LSOAS are in the second most deprived category.






#### IMD: Education, Skills and Training

This map shows education, skills and training deprivation on the index of multiple deprivation. The darker shading of an area represents a higher level of deprivation.

- 9 LSOAs are in the most deprived group for education, skills and training.
- A further 6 LSOAS are in the second most deprived category.



#### IMD: Health and Disability

The large map shows Letchworth's score for health deprivation and disability on the Index of Multiple Deprivation. Darker colours represent higher levels of deprivation.

• 10 of Letchworth's LSOAs are in the top 20% most deprived in Hertfordshire for health and disability.

 A further 5 LSOAs are in the top 40% most deprived in Hertfordshire for health and disability.


• This map shows the number of people with a long term illness or disability. 11 LSOAs are in the most affected 20% for this measure, at a rate of 17.5 – 31.5% of the population.



#### IMD: Crime and Disorder

This map shows Letchworth's crime and disorder score on the index of multiple deprivation. The darkest areas are the most deprived.

• 6 LSOAs score very highly on this measure, with a further 5 in the top 40% worst affected.






#### IMD: Housing and Living Environment

This map shows the housing and living environment score for Letchworth. This measure takes into account both indoor and outdoor environments in the area.

- Letchworth scores well on this measure compared with the other 6, with only two LSOAs in the top 20% most deprived areas.
- A further 6 LSOAs are in the top 40% most deprived areas.






#### IMD: Employment Deprivation

This map shows the employment deprivation in Letchworth.

•11 LSOAs are in the top 20% most deprived for employment.

• A further 6 areas are in the top 40% most deprived for employment.

• The areas of deprivation are focused around the Grange, Wilbury, Letchworth East and the Jackmans.






#### IMD: Income Deprivation

This map shows Letchworth's score for income deprivation.

- 9 areas are in the top 20% most deprived.
- 6 areas are in the top 40% more deprived.
- The areas of income deprivation are focused around the Grange, Wilbury, Letchworth East and the Jackmans Estate.






#### IMD: Income Deprivation Affecting Older People

This map shows income deprivation affecting older people

• 8 areas are in the top 20% for income deprivation affecting older people.

• A further 4 are in the top 40%.






#### IMD: Income Deprivation Affecting Children

This map shows income deprivation affecting children.

• The 9 areas which are very deprived in terms of general income deprivation unsurprisingly score high for the measure in income deprivation affecting children. A further area in Letchworth East is also in the 20% most affected.

6 further LSOAs are in the top 40% most affected.





•30% of Letchworth school children are eligible for Free School Meals (2015)

• In 2014, 19% of children in Letchworth East came from low-income families, 18% in Letchworth Grange, 19% in Letchworth South East, 11% in Letchworth South West, and 22% in Letchworth Wilbury.

• 11% of Letchworth households are lone parent families, compared to 9% in North Herts as a whole (2011)
